STEPHEN PARKS

Stephen Parks holds a B.A. degree from Trinity College, Hartford, CT and is a graduate of the U.S. Navy's Officer's Candidate School in Newport, RI. Stephen Parks moved to Taos in 1973 where he worked for some years as a freelance writer/editor for Taos Magazine and other publications. In 1980 he founded ARTlines, a journal covering arts and artists in northern New Mexico, and served as its editor until 1985. He and his wife opened Parks Gallery in 1993, which remains one of Taos' most prominent galleries. He is the author of two arts books, R.C. Gorman: A Portrait and Jim Wagner: American Artist. He is actively involved in theatre arts. Parks has acted in and directed scores of production and has written several plays.

The Colorado State Fair Fine Arts Exhibition is a juried competition. All artwork is juried and only the works accepted by the jurors will be displayed in the Fine Arts Gallery during the Colorado State Fair, August 23-September 2, 2013. The jurors have sole responsibility for the selection of artwork to be exhibited and awarded under their authority. The jurors' decisions are final. The jury process is closed and confidential.

- If I submitted my artwork as an ELECTRONIC SUBMISSION and received notice that my artwork was accepted I know that I must deliver it or ship it to the Fairgrounds by **Wednesday, August 7, 5:00pm**.
- If I was notified that my artwork was not-accepted I know that I must pick it up before Sunday, August 11 at 5:00pm or leave it in storage at the Fairgrounds until Wednesday, September 4, 10am-6pm..
- I know that all artwork (stored or exhibited) will be released Wednesday, September 4, 10:00am to 6:00pm Fine Arts Gallery.
