- Show order futurity heifers, heifers, steers, pen of 3 heifers, pen of 3 steers
- All steers or heifers will be entered and shown individually. Steers
  or heifers shown as individuals are not required to be owned
  by the exhibitor. A "pen of three" competition will follow the
  individual steer or heifer shows. To be eligible, all three steers or
  heifers must be bred and owned by the exhibitor and must be
  entered in the name of the exhibitor.
- All calves will be stalled together if possible. Stalling request to Jay Nansel at phone number above. Preference to those that request being stalled with another exhibitor, no guarantees.
- NILE will furnish a committee to determine those steers/heifers
  that meet the rules and regulations of the show. This committee
  will sift any animal on quality that they feel is not representative
  of feeder calves that will mature into exhibition show market
  steers/heifers. Entry fees are forfeited in the event that calves
  are sifted or fail to arrive at the show and/or sale.
- Steers and heifers will be tagged and weighed for show classification between 3 - 5 p.m. on Tuesday, October 15, 2013. A weigh sheet, listing weight & corresponding lot numbers, will be available prior to sale.
- Steers and heifers will be shown by weight and not by breed. The superintendent will divide them into equal classes by weight. The "pens of three" will be shown and judged in one class for steers and one class for heifers
- Steers and heifers must be fitted, broke to lead, and shown on halter. Sale and moving arrangements dictate calves must be led when moving from one area to another. A halter must remain on the calf after the sale. If a consignor fails to comply with this rule, a rope halter will be purchased and cost charged to consignor.
- Entries will be limited to six (6) head of steers and six (6) head of heifers maximum per owner.
- Steer and heifer entries entered in the show must be "marketable feeders" i.e., free from lump jaw, blindness, <u>or horns</u>, evidence of late castration, or otherwise not marketable cattle. Calves showing excessive age may be eliminated from competition.
- All steers entered into the show must sell. The sale committee
  will determine the number of heifers eligible for the sale. Animals
  eligible to sell not going through the sale ring will be charged a
  \$500 no sale fee. It shall be the responsibility of exhibitors to
  "protect" the sale price, thus there will be no "No Sales" going
  through the ring. Sellers pay commission on the last bid. Once the
  gavel falls, an animal has been purchased no exceptions.
- Checks will be mailed to consignors within 15 banking days, made payable to owner and lien holder if applicable.
- NILE Club Calf Futurity: NILE will withhold \$30 from sale check of all animals in the sale for partial funding of Futurity, unless notified

by seller in writing.

 Steers will sell individually by the head. Sale commission fee 8% on all animals sold.

- The sale order will be grand champion steer, reserve grand champion steer, grand champion heifer, reserve grand champion heifer, grand champion pen of 3 steers, and reserve grand champion pen of 3 steers. The remaining animals will be sold in show order. If steer or heifer is not present for sale at designated time, it will be sold at the end of sale.
- An animal eliminated from the show by the sifting committee or the judge will not sell and must be removed to a separate area prior to the sale. Arrangements can be made to sell the sifted animal through the local sale yard.
- Complaints and sale disputes should first be directed to the superintendent, whose decision is final and enforceable.
- NILE acts only as an agent for the consignors in the sale and does not assume any responsibility while the animal is on grounds, during loading or transportation, or for the animal's future usefulness. All guarantees are strictly between the buyer and seller
- Pen of Three Competition: \$50 per Pen Entry Fee. Calves must be entered and shown individually. Please enter on entry form.

Grand champion steer/heifer - \$300 + NILE jacket Reserve grand champion steer/heifer - \$150+ NILE vest Grand champion pen of three steers/heifers - \$100 Reserve grand champion pen of three steers/heifers - \$75 Class Ribbons to four places.

## NILE Club Calf Steer & Heifer Futurity

All steers and heifers sold through the sale are eligible for entry to the 6th Annual NILE Club Calf Futurity. Entry fee for the futurity is \$30 per head on sale day and \$60 after sale day until December 31st. All futurity payments must be in by December 31, 2013. Hair samples from sale animals will be taken at the time of weigh-in for identity purposes. The determining show for the 2013 steer futurity winner will be held in June 2014. Location to be determined. The determining show for the 2014 heifer futurity winner will be held during NILE 2014.

Registered buyer of the steer/heifer must be present to show animal in Futurity Show, no substitute show person will be allowed. All exhibitors in the final show of the Futurity will receive a windshirt. Payouts will be based upon entries to the futurity.
